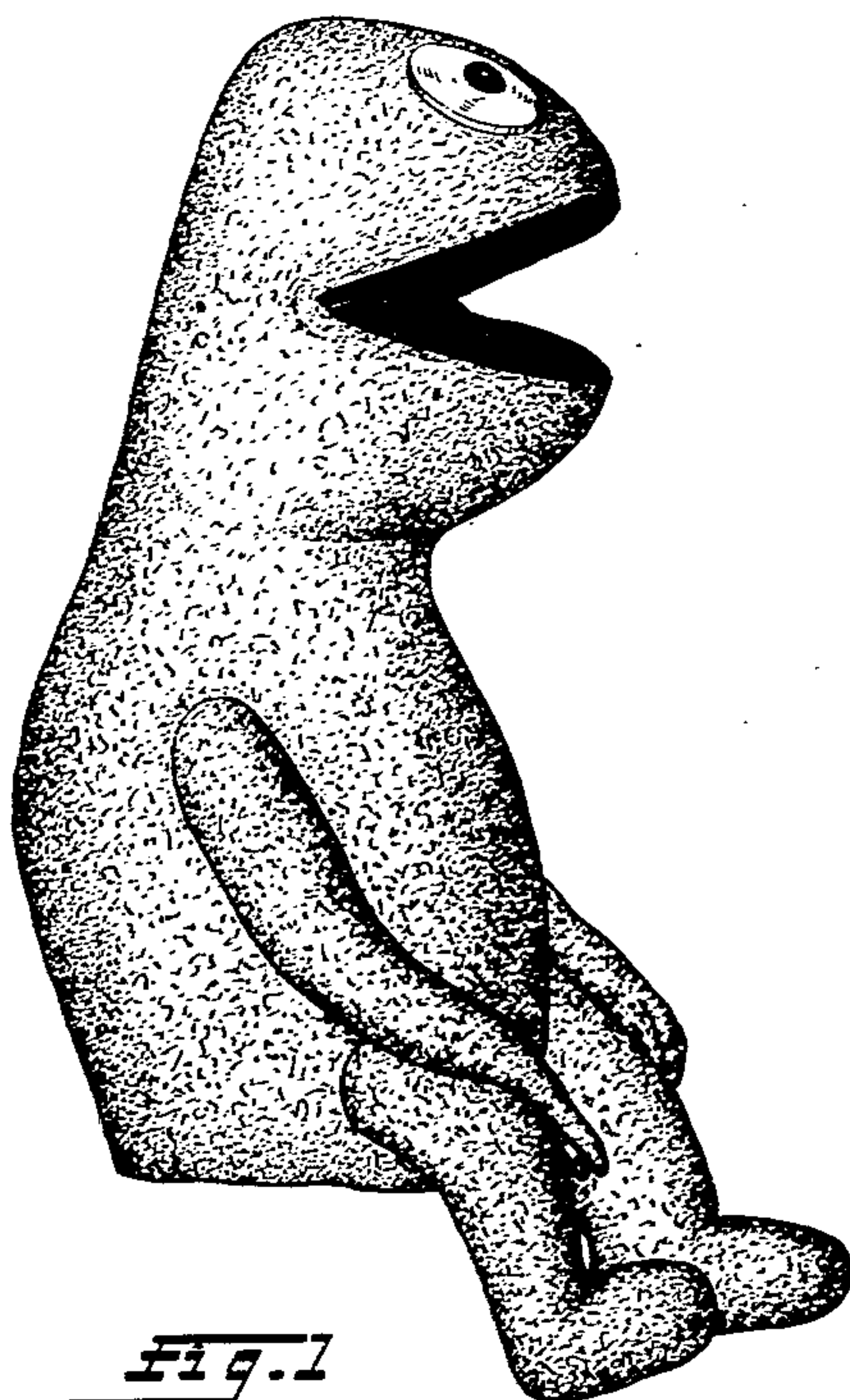
PUPPET DOLL OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

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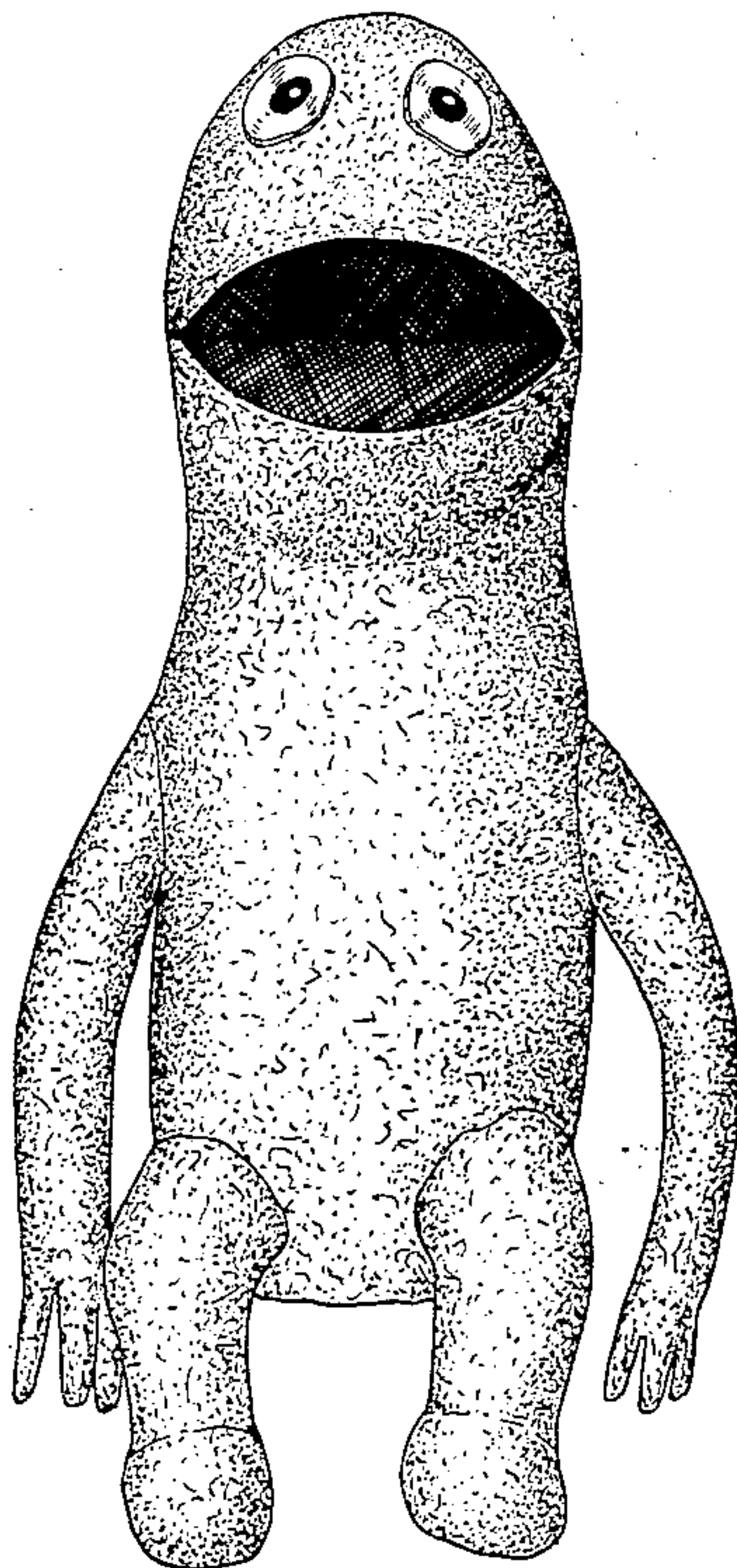

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a puppet doll or similar article showing my new design (the side elevation being the same from either side).
